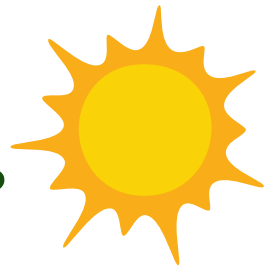

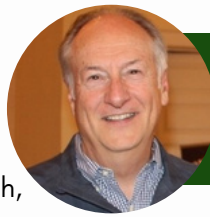

•The men cooked and served a delicious Valentine's Day Dinner for their dazzling dates.

•We partnered with Love & Whimsy Events to create Galentine's Day where Lyceum women sampled food, drink, and beauty products; while shopping from small local boutiques.

•Jenny Wheeler, our GM, Devon Davis, and our EC, Addi Richardson finalized our 2024 social calendar that's chock full of engaging events.

•Our General Manager and new Event Coordinator (Addi Richardson) have been busy booking wedding, parties and meetings for the balance of the year. So far this year, 44 events have been booked worth an estimated rental revenue of \$149,525.08; which is a significant improvement over the 50 events and rental revenue of \$98,189.79 of last year. 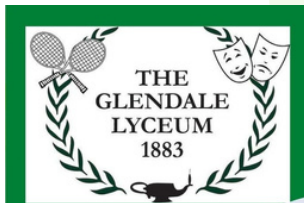
