

A very Happy New Year to all as 2023 begins and we say goodbye to 2022.

The end of the year was a busy time celebrating the holiday season and making memories at the Lyceum with parties, events, and activities. Thank you to all Directors, committees, and volunteers who made the club look and feel so festive with decorations, lighting, the fabulous new Christmas tree (thank you Randy Green), and joyful music. A special thanks to all members who donated generously to the GPD Adopt-A-Family Giving Tree. It's what the Christmas spirit is all about.

Your Board met and reviewed our financial picture in December giving careful consideration to our operating budget, expenses, rental income, dues, and fees. As with our members, the Lyceum is likewise not immune to the spiraling effects of inflation and rising prices. The Board voted to increase full member dues by 7% and to increase racquet member dues by 5% effective January 1 to meet this challenge. Please know that the Board's deliberations included several options for addressing these issues and also recognized that the club has not had a full member dues increase since 2019.

January brings our Annual Meeting, and I look forward to seeing you there. The Board will present a review of 2022 and we will be electing three new members. Our slate of nominees is full of talented people so vote absentee or vote in person on January 23. Please make plans to attend the meeting--your participation is important to the life of our club.

The January meeting will also be my last on the Board. It has been a great honor and privilege to serve. I have happily worked with generous and enthusiastic Directors and want to specifically recognize and thank the other Directors finishing their terms this year: Susan Swaine, Holy Tenhundfeld, and Scott Vaaler. I also want to thank our dedicated staff of Devon Davis, Erin Johnson, Jackie Vaughn, and Phillip Shively and all they contribute to the success of the Lyceum. It is very much appreciated.



Important Update

YOUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS MET AT ITS DECEMBER MEETING TO REVIEW AND EVALUATE THE LYCEUM'S FINANCES. AS YOU ARE AWARE, OUR CLUB OPERATIONS ARE MAINLY FUNDED BY MEMBER DUES, FEES, DIVIDENDS FROM OUR INVESTMENT PORTFOLIO, AND FACILITY RENTALS. THOSE SOURCES OF INCOME DO NOT ALWAYS COVER OUR EXPENSES AND WE ARE NOW FACING AN OPERATIONAL SHORTFALL.

THE REASONS FOR THIS ARE PRIMARILY DUE TO STAFF SALARY ADJUSTMENTS AND EXTERNAL INFLATIONARY PRESSURES, NEITHER OF WHICH THE LYCEUM CAN ESCAPE IN THE CURRENT ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT. THE BOARD CONSIDERED THE BEST OPTIONS IN TAKING ACTION IN THIS SITUATION, WHICH IS NECESSARY FOR THE CLUB'S LONG-TERM FINANCIAL HEALTH.

IN ORDER TO ADDRESS OUR BUDGET SHORTFALL, THE BOARD HAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED A 7% DUES INCREASE FOR FULL MEMBERSHIP, WHICH HAS NOT HAD AN INCREASE SINCE 2019. A 5% DUES INCREASE FOR RACQUET MEMBERS WAS ALSO APPROVED. WHILE INCREASING DUES OF ANY KIND IS NEVER AN EASY DECISION, WE ARE ALSO LOOKING AT OTHER WAYS TO GENERATE REVENUE TO BRIDGE THE BUDGET GAP INCLUDING INCREASING GUEST, COURT, AND RENTAL FEES AND FINDING WAYS TO FURTHER DECREASE EXPENSES.

THE BOARD HAS MADE THIS DECISION THROUGH THOUGHTFUL CONSIDERATION OF ALL ISSUES AND IN RECOGNITION OF HOW MUCH WE ALL VALUE OUR CLUB. WE APPRECIATE EVERYONE'S SUPPORT ON THIS.

WITH THESE ADJUSTMENTS BEING MADE, YOU MAY SEE A SMALL DELAY IN RECEIVING YOUR JANUARY BILL/STATEMENT.




