# Member Memos

Effective June 2, the state of Ohio will lift all existing health orders for social gatherings, including the requirement to socially distance, wear a mask, and the need to serve food from behind protective barriers. The Glendale Lyceum will also lift these restrictions at this time, except in the cases of preparing and serving food. Committees should expect to serve food onto plates while wearing gloves. Committees should also prepare non-communal appetizers that don't require direct touching of food - toothpicks on shrimp or bowls of chips with self-serve tongs would be acceptable. As always, it is a responsible and effective practice to frequently wash your hands for at least 20-seconds, or apply hand sanitation when soap and water are not accessible. We thank our members for your flexibility, perseverance, and patience over the past year, especially to committee members who faced many unique challenges brought on by the former restrictions. We're looking forward to some of our more familiar events and activities to resume, and in a way that is fun and comfortable for all.

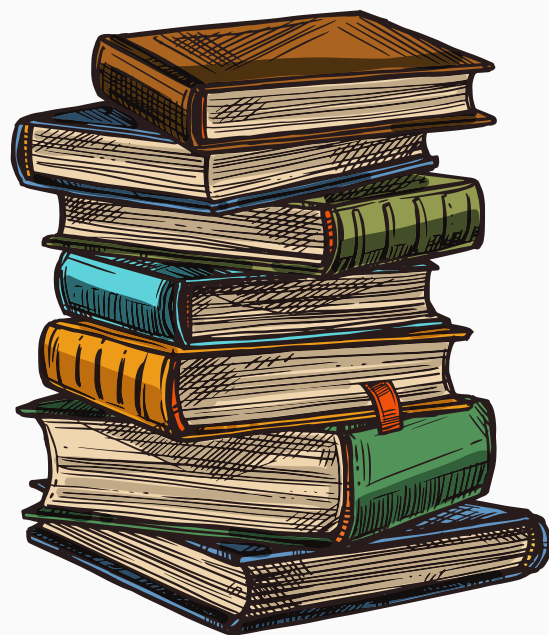

Drop Off will be 9:20-9:30 a.m. Please accompany or send your camper to the pavilion to let Ms. Becky know you've arrived.

Ms. Becky will manage sign-in at the pavilion, but children are welcome to walk from home without a parent if appropriate. Emergency release forms will be sent to each registrant, and should be returned no later than the first day of camp. Pool time will be 12:00 - 12:30 with extended time on Fridays, but campers should be picked-up no later than 1:00 unless camper is staying at pool and Ms. Becky is aware of pick-up situation.

Swimmers over the age of 9 who have passed the swim test may swim without a parent or guardian present.

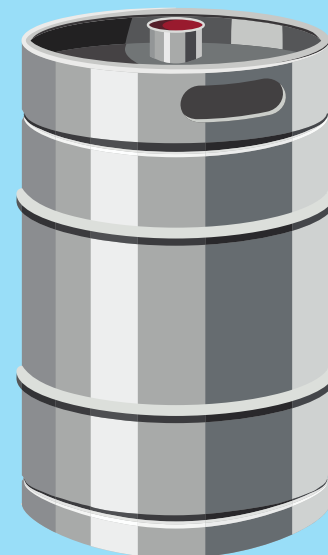
