

Playtomic

As of May 18th, we have officially upgraded our court booking system to Playtomic from FastCourts. You are now able to start booking courts through the Playtomic App or via the https://playtomic.io website. Instructions are available for how to do so on both the app and the web interface upon request.

When signing up for the Playtomic app, it will ask you several questions. It asks for a photo for your profile page. Just upload any photo you'd like. Then it will ask about your ability level for which ever sport you chose (tennis or padel). They do not have pickleball or platform tennis as a choice, so just select either tennis or padel for now and answer the questions the best that you can. The ability level that you will be assigned isn't something that we will be using. We are only going to be using their court reservation system for the time being.

Once you set up your profile, you can easily access the booking portion of Playtomic to reserve courts. Again, we have documents for reference on how to book courts and you can also visit Playtomic's YouTube page for many helpful tutorials.

Heather Geary, Devon Davis and I are all familiar with the new system and will do our best to help you if you have any questions.




