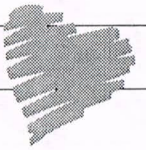

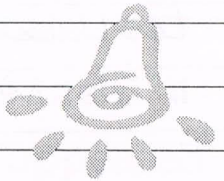

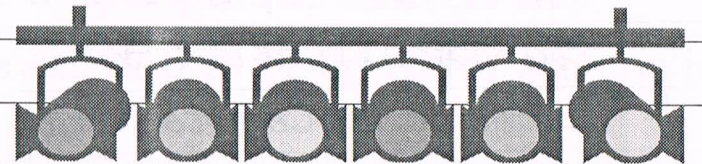

Stella in *Light Up the Sky*

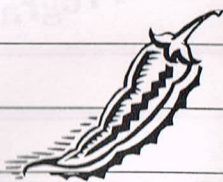
Big Mama in *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof*

Jack Lower (Professor Burgess)

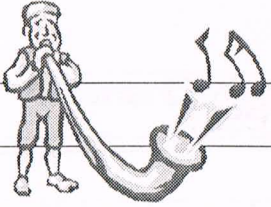

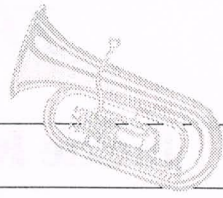
Chris Underwood (Sally)

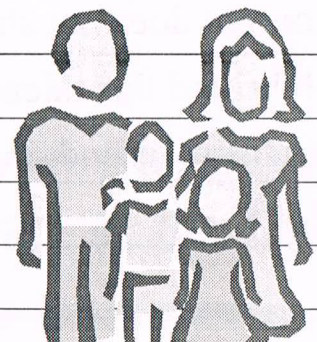


Ralph Winterhalter (Mike)

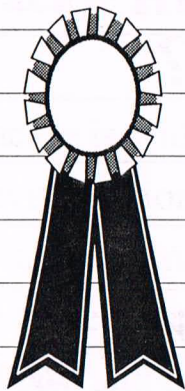
