

Who's Who

Joe D'Amato (Playwright & Frank DeRosa)

Joe's first appearance on the stage was as Samuuel Jonas (a New Yorker) in the Lyceum's production of *The Second Time Around*. We all remember the dazzling red jacket he wore while portraying Schlegal, the circus owner in *Carnival*.

"He now returns to the role he knows best", says his wife Linda of 25 years, "a grouchy New Yorker."

"It's easy to prepare for a role like this when you're the writer", Joe says. "If you can't remember the line, you change it to something you can remember!"

"I guess the biggest thrill for me as a first time playwright, is hearing my written words come to life. *Christmas with Anton* has been very satisfying for me. I hope it is for you."

Betty Kooris (Director & Mary DeRosa)

Betty has extensive stage experience beginning in grade school and continuing through high school where she had the lead in *Our Town*. In college she performed in *Medea*, *Marat/Sade*, *The Glass Menagerie*, *Caesar and Cleopatra* and *Lysistrata*.


Who's Who
