THE DIRECTORS

JOE D'AMATO

Joe's first appearance on the stage as an actor was as Samuel Jonas (a New Yorker) in the Lyceum's production of *The Second Time Around*. And we all remember the dazzling red jacket he wore while portraying Schlegal, the circus owner in *Carnival*.

The theater now fully in his blood, Joe wrote his own play, Christmas With Anton, which premiered at the Lyceum in December 2000. "I guess the biggest thrill for me as a first time playwright, was hearing my written words come to life. Christmas with Anton was very satisfying for me."

Joe volunteered to direct Life With Father and it is his debut as a Director.

NANCY GREEN

Since returning to Glendale ten years ago, Nancy has directed numerous children's productions at church, Glendale Elementary School and The Glendale Lyceum.

She made her Lyceum acting debut in 1998 as Jane Elliot in Cocktails With Mimi and that same year she directed the Lyceum Stunt Night.

THE ACTORS

SCOTT RUSSELL (FATHER)

Scott is a newcomer to Glendale and the Lyceum, having moved here from San Diego. He was a film, television, and radio production major at the University of Missouri. He's appeared in student films, one-act plays and on college radio. At one time, he was part of a three-person, improvisational comedy team called "Food Fit For A Chain Gang".

"The sense of community I've found in Glendale and at the Lyceum has touched me. I see this (Life With Father) as a way to know my neighbors better, live an expanded role in the community, and have fun!"

MYRNA STUART (VINNIE)

Myrna's most recent credits include Jenny Kissed Me, Lo and Behold, Cheaper By The Dozen, Run For Your Wife, Last of the Red Hot Lovers, Second Time Around, and Plaza Suite.

"After playing the last two hysterical females, I wanted to do something normal — although Vinnie is 'sweetly manipulative'! I wanted to be a part of traditional American theatre, to be involved in dramatic education for children, and to provide the audience with a piece of nostalgia that could make them smile. Thank you to my husband for being supportive and patient. I promise to be a cook again soon. Thank you to Joe (D'amato) for being so BRAVE!!"

THE ACTORS

JACK LAZZARO (CLARENCE)

Jack had some big shoes to fill in a very short time. When the actor who was originally cast as Clarence was unable to perform, Jack stepped in with only two and a half weeks before "show time". Jack is a sophomore at the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music. He has played the son in Six Characters in Search of an Author, the master of the ship in The Tempest and Oswald & Foogman in Giants Have Us in Their Books.

Jack tells us he agreed to play the role of Clarence "because I'm Italian and I value my legs!"

JOE BESL (JOHN)

This is Joe's first real stage experience. He has participated in two grade school plays – one is First grade and another in Sixth grade. He seems to be a natural – you be the judge!

"I'm in this play mostly because I wanted to try acting in a more professional way than a grade school play. I was also told to be in the play by Paul Breidenbach, Steve Geary and Joe D'amato."

HAESSLY FRANTZ (MARY SKINNER)

Haessly has participated in a number of plays including *The Complete Works of William Shakespeare Abridged, The Wiz,* the Lyceum's *Carnival*, as well as summer camp skits, various ballet recitals and the *Nutcracker*. She says that she really "enjoys acting".

Ashley, who is 10, has enjoyed participating in school performances. She has taken dance lessons for four years and piano lessons for two years. She made her stage debut as Hannah in Joe D'amato's original *Christmas With Anton*. Ashley and her family moved to Glendale in 1999 and became members of the Lyceum. She loves to act and is grateful for the opportunity to be a part of the cast of *Life With Father*.

FARLEY SAWYER (WHITNEY)



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



