#### FRASIER BACKSTORY

The two acts performed tonight are drawn from the Frasier TV show, which aired in 11 seasons from 1993 through 2004. The show was a spin off from Cheers (which also ran 11 seasons) and is considered one of the most successful series in television history. Frasier garnered much critical acclaim, winning a total of 37 Primetime Emmy Awards during its run, breaking the record held by the Mary Tyler Moore show. At the time, the show also had the most consecutive wins for Outstanding Comedy Series, winning from 1994 to 1998.

The principal players on Frasier were:

Kelsey Grammer as Frasier Crane David Hyde Pierce as Niles Crane John Mahoney as Martin Crane Peri Gilpin as Roz Doyle Jane Leeves as Daphne Moon Moose as Eddie (the dog)

A bit of backstory for those unfamiliar with the series:

Dr. Frasier Crane, is semi recently divorced and has moved back to Seattle from Boston. His dad, Martin, a retired cop shot in the line of duty, has had to move into Frasier's apartment – a source of discomfort for both son and father. Frasier has hired the slightly psychic Daphne Moon as a live in caretaker for Martin.

Frasier makes his living in Seattle as the host of a call in radio talk show on KACL for people looking for quick psychiatric advice. Roz Doyle produces his show and is perennially on the hunt for a man.

Dr. Niles Crane, Frasier's younger brother, is also a psychiatrist, but runs a conventional practice. He is married to a wealthy but extremely reclusive woman named Maris – a character referred to constantly throughout the show, but never seen or heard throughout the entire series. Niles carries a torch for Daphne, a secret to just about no one except Daphne.

#### ACT I

The first act of our performance is based on the episode that concluded the first season of Frasier. Titled My Coffee With Niles, it originally aired on May 19th, 1994. Frasier is meeting his brother Niles for coffee at their habitual haunt, Café Nervosa. Niles tries unsuccessfully to gauge Frasier's happiness with his new life and ends up revealing his own frustrations. Tempers also come to a head between Martin and Frasier over living arrangements and overlooked milestones.

#### ACT 2

The second act of our performance is based on an episode titled Dinner Party that aired six years later.

By this time, Frasier and Martin have come (more or less) to terms with sharing an apartment. Niles has recently divorced Maris, but has still never acted on his feelings for Daphne.

The episode is set entirely within Frasier's apartment, and as the title suggests, Frasier and Niles are trying to plan a dinner party.

A conflict develops between their planning and Martin's monthly poker game. Meanwhile, Daphne and Roz are preparing for a fancy ball at the British Consulate.

## Who's Who in the Cast



#### Jim Wesselman- Dr. Fraiser Crane

I am a Glendale resident and Lyceum member. My first roles were two minor parts in Joe D'Amato's "Christmas with Anton". I was Juror #3 in "Twelve Angry Men". I then played the part of Oscar Madison in "Odd Couple". My next role was as Sidney Bruhl in "Death Trap". All of my roles have been performed at the Glendale Lyceum, because no one else would have me!



#### Jay Wheeler-Dr. Niles Crane

Does this place have a five-timers club? If so, add my name to the list! After a year off, I'm happy to be back on the Lyceum stage. Previous appearances include Deathtrap, Last of the Red Hot Lovers and The Odd Couple. And, of course, the role that started it all for me: the time-obsessed and largely silent Juror #2 in Twelve Angry Men.




#### Goliath Pfirrmann-Eddie-
