

Who's Who in the Cast



HEATHER GEARY - MARY DEROSA

SCOTT MORGAN - FRANK DEROSA

Like many Glendalians, Scott got his acting start in the village play The Rebels Are Coming where he proudly announced the first words of the play, "I ain't seen no rebels" as Soldier Number 1, thereby setting the whole tone of the Act. Later he portrayed

The Telegraph Operator who arguably became the hero of the play by single-handedly saving the town of Madison through tact and deception (take that Randy Green!). In Act two, as Guy Whittling a Stick, he reported to a Union Officer played by Joe D'Amato, where Joe observed just enough of a heartbeat to later cast Scott in the Lyceum's 12 Angry Men as protagonist Juror Number 8 some year's later and a previous stint in Anton as Doc. He has also appeared on Loveland Stage in the Philadelphia Story and Young Frankenstein. He has also been easily persuaded to help out in many stage crews at Loveland by local legend Glenna Knap.




